Vermont met its membership goal to increase to 75 members! All attendees received canvas totes for all members as well as membership pins.
- WRCC did not purchase the curriculum, but their school paid for 2023-2024 membership.
- 2023-2024 incentive funds were used to pay for members attending the Norwich University Education Conference as well as the Teacherfest at Plymouth State University.
- Michelle Dean, New England Educators Rising Representative, supported the Vermont state chapter by virtually meeting with teacher leaders at Champlain College in March to work on strategies to develop it. She plans to attend in person the TEC meeting in the fall at Lake Morey Resort.
